



INTRODUCTION of AJOU GSIS

The Graduate School of International Studies at Ajou University was established in 1996 as a pioneer of professional studies programs in Korea. The founding motivation of Ajou GSIS was to meet the growing global demand of international academic institute. At present, Ajou GSIS has over 1,250 alumni students in more than 80 countries worldwide, who play important roles at their respective positions in government agencies and global enterprises. It is Ajou GSIS's main role to educate the future leaders professionally and academically for this increasingly complex global society. Also encouraging students to explore the very best out of their time and giving opportunity to discover their talents as a global leader are Ajou GSIS's main focus.

Ajou GSIS currently offers five different majors with the courses that are applicable in the real international fields; International Business, International Trade, International Development and Cooperation, Civil Society Studies and Energy Studies. Also since 2004, Ajou GSIS has been funded by KOICA (Korea International Cooperation Agency) to educate government officials from developing countries in international business, international trade, civil society studies and energy studies, and has produced around 309 graduates until today.

The Most Diverse International Student Population

More than 84 nationalities are represented every semester including students from Asia, Oceania, Europe, Africa and America(North/Central/South). Ajou University maintains the highest foreign student enrollment in Korea. The university's increasing diversity is the most important and enduring asset of the Graduate School of International Studies.

QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION

In order to be admitted as a graduate student, applicants are expected to have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution or in the final semester to obtain a Bachelor's degree at an internationally recognized university or college. Or, applicants should have an equivalent qualification to a Bachelor's degree which is approved by the Ministry of Education of their respected countries.

When making the payment, applicants should write down his/her name in order to verify the sender. Failure to write down the applicant's full name may result in the payment not being received by the University, thus may be unable to release the final admission package to the applicant

In addition, applicants should pay handling fees (such as money transferring fee of 20 USD) when filling out the international money transfer form at his/her banks in his/her country. Ajou University WILL NOT pay any handling fees of the applicant's remittance and any handling fees charged to Ajou University by mistake of the applicants WILL BE CHARGED AGAIN to the applicants upon arrival to Ajou University. Applicants should keep in mind that it takes about 2-3 days to finally confirm the receipt of the fees at the Bank in Ajou University. Therefore, the applicants should plan to send the fees 2-3 days prior to the deadlines set up by the University.



- * GSIS strongly recommends that all applicants submit their Online Application Form before the deadline of the 1st or 2nd round of admission.
- * Chinese students SHOULD send all their documents by the deadline of the 1st round of admission due to visa matter.
- * All students who declared to study at the GSIS should come to the GSIS before the Orientation date and should complete final registration upon arrival to the Ajou University. Students who cannot come before the Orientation date should clearly inform the GSIS office of their expected arrival date via email. GSIS Admission will be withdrawn when students DO NOT come to the university 2 weeks after the semester begins.

- 3. A copy of Alien Registration Card (only for Korean Residents)
- 4. English Proficiency Test Score
 - * Official Test of English as a foreign Language(TOEFL) or International Language Testing System(IELTS) or Equivalent English Proficiency Test Score
 - * Above TOEFL-IBT 80, IELTS 5.5
 - * Students from the countries where the official language is English should submit the Certificate that shows the medium of language was English in the undergraduate program.

5. Statement of Purpose (SOP)

* During the online application process, you will be requested to fill out the SOP form. (Minimum 500 words and maximum 2000 words.)

- Required to upload the documents below at 'Required Documents' section of Online Application (Forms(Statement of Purpose(SOP) / Recommendation Letter / Agreement Form for Academic Verification) can be downloaded at http://gsis.ajou.ac.kr)
 - * All documents necessary for admission application should be provided with original documents via post.
 - * When original documents are written in a language other than English, applicants should submit the notarized and English translated version.
 - * All the documents are non-returnable.

* Should be notarized by the Korean Embassy. In apostille countries, applicants should get apostille.

2. Official Transcript of all undergraduate work

- * Should be notarized by the Korean Embassy. In apostille countries, applicants should get apostille.
- * When there is no explanation of the university's grading system on the transcript, explanation of one's home university's grading system should be included along with the transcript.
- 3. [GSIS Form] Two letters of recommendation from professors at an undergraduate institute or supervisors
 - * At least one letter must come from a professor of your undergraduate institute
- 4. One original copy of Verification of Deposit(VOD) of the person responsible for students' expenses (only under applicant OR parents' name)
 - * Should have more than 20,000 USD in the deposit / Personal account only(VOD of the corporate is not acceptable)
- 5. Relationship Certificate (only when the VOD is in the name of the applicant's parents)
- 6. Certificate of Income (only when the VOD is in the name of the applicant's parents)
- 7. [GSIS Form] Agreement form for Academic Verification
- 8. Application fee of USD 100 payment receipt
 - * When the payment is made in KRW, please pay KRW 100,000.
 - * Please remember that your admission process will only begin after the payment.



HOUSING INFORMATION

The dormitory at Ajou University accommodates 2,400 students in four modern buildings. International graduate students are normally placed at Hwahong hall and New international dormitory.
